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### INTRODUCTION

The following document outlines Melksham Without Parish Council's information to be published, as per the requirement of the Local Government Transparency Code 2015.

The Code, issued to meet the Government's desire to increase democratic accountability, includes items such as Expenditure over £ 500, Land and Asset Values, and Grants to Voluntary, Community and Social Enterprise Organisations. The Code can be viewed on the following website:

Local authorities are encouraged to consider their responses, in accordance with the principle that all data held and managed by them should be made open and available to local people unless there are specific sensitivities to doing so.

The Code is issued by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government in exercise of his powers under Section 2 of Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 ("the Act") to issue a Code of Recommended Practice ("the Code") as to the publication of information by local authorities about the discharge of their functions and other matters which he considers to be related. It is issued following consultation in accordance with section 3(11) of the Act.

The Code does not replace or supersede the existing legal framework for access to and re-use of public sector information provided by the:

- Freedom of Information Act 2000 (as amended by the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012)
- Environmental Information Regulations 2004
- Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations 2005
- Infrastructure for Spatial Information in the European Community (INSPIRE) Regulations 2009, and
- Sections 25 and 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 which provides rights for persons to inspect a local authority's accounting records and supporting documentation, and to make copies of them.

One of the definitions of a local authority under the transparency code is "a parish council which has a gross annual income or expenditure (whichever is higher) exceeding £200,000."

The parish council has reached the £200,000 threshold for the year ending 31st March 2020.

### Part 2.1 Item 31 & 32 - **PROCUREMENT INFORMATION**

During the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 Melksham Without Parish Council published two invitations to Tender with a value over £5,000. The tender exercises were conducted by Arthur Williams Consulting Ltd, on behalf of the parish council, in his role as appointed Project Manager for the new Village Hall at Berryfield project. The appointment of the Project Manager is documented in Minute 324/19 of Finance Committee 16<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

# 1. To appoint Principle Designer/Lead Consultant for Berryfield Village Hall Project

- Service up to and including submission of planning application
- Service up to and including submission of Building Regulations application
- Service up to and including preparation of tender documents
- Supervision of Building Contract up to and including 12 months Defects liability period
- Provisional sum for mechanical/ electrical/ structural / civil engineering services, CDM Adviser & topographical survey of £25,000

## 2. To appoint Cost Co-ordination Consultant for the Berryfield Village Hall Project

- 3. The Parish Council resolved on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019 (Min. 127/19 c) The Parish Council do not go out to tender for the grass cutting contract as they are happy with the service provided by the incumbent contractor, J H Jones, and the easy accessibility of this contractor to provide numerous other services with a rapid response.
- 4. The Parish Council noted on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2019 (Min. 324/19) that Finance Regulation 11.1a ii) relating to specialist services "..... this regulation need not apply to contracts which relate to.... ii) for specialist services such as provided by solicitors, accountants, surveyors and planning consultants"

# During the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 Melksham Without Parish Council issued the following orders with a value over £5,000.

 Appointed Arthur Williams Consulting Ltd as Project Manager at a cost of £7,875 + VAT for the Berryfield Village Hall build project, which included a sum of £1,800 + VAT for project management services up to submission of the application for planning permission. (See Min. 324/19 Finance Committee 16<sup>th</sup> December 2019).

- **2.** Appointed Martin Pickard as Cost Co-ordination Consultant for the Berryfield Village Hall build project at a cost of £4,900.00. (See Min. 449/19 Finance Committee 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020)
- Appointed BTA Architects Ltd as t Principle Designer/ Lead Consultant for the Berryfield Village Hall project at a cost of £38,000 excluding VAT. (See Min.417/19 Asset Management Committee 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020)
- **4.** To appoint J H Jones for 3 year grass cutting contract from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 at an overall cost of £48,139.75 (See Min. 448/19 Finance Committee 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020).

The rules governing how the Parish Council operates are its Standing Orders, and its Financial Regulations govern its finance operations. Both are published on the parish council's website and are reviewed at least annually at the Annual Council meeting held in May.

### Part 2.2 Item 51 - PAY MULTIPLE

Section 38 of the Localism Act 2011 required local authorities to publish a statement on the relationship between remuneration of chief officers and the remuneration of other staff. This is recommended to be demonstrated as a pay multiple to illustrate the authority's approach to pay dispersion.

17:10 is the ratio of the Clerk remuneration to the median of the rest of the staff.
